**PREKINDERGARTEN: Brooklyn offers a half day prekindergarten program.**

A five day per week program is available to students who are or will turn four by December 31, 2018 or who are enrolled under our School Readiness grant.

Two and three day per week programming is available to students who are or will turn three by December 31, 2018. Generally, students who turn three January 1st - July 1st are placed in three day per week sessions and those who turn three July 1st- December 31st attend two days per week.

*It is important to register for prekindergarten during this registration period, as slots tend to fill up quickly and space is limited.*

**KINDERGARTEN: Kindergarten is full day in Brooklyn. Children must be five years of age by December 31, 2018 to enroll.**

Although it is not necessary for children already enrolled in the Brooklyn prekindergarten program to re-register or to register for kindergarten; all parents must submit an updated physical exam and immunization record before the start of school in September 2018.

Minimum immunization requirements prior to school entry are as follows for:

PREKINDERGARTEN	KINDERGARTEN
DTaP: 4 doses	DTaP: at least 4 doses last one given on or after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday
Polio: 3 doses	Polio: at least 3 doses last one given on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday
MMR: 1 dose	MMR: 2 doses
Hib: 1 dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday	Hib: 1 dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday for children <5
Hep A: 2 doses	Hep A: 2 doses
Hep B: 3 doses	Hep B: 3 doses
Varicella: 1 dose	Varicella: 2 doses
Pneumo: 1 dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday	Pneumo: 1 dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday for children <5
Flu Vaccine: 1 dose administered each year between August 1 <sup>st</sup> - -December 31st	

\*Parents must bring their child's original birth certificate, proof of residency (rental agreement or mortgage statement), W-2's or tax return for 2017 (used to determine grant eligibility), current physical exam and complete immunization record with them on the day of registration.
